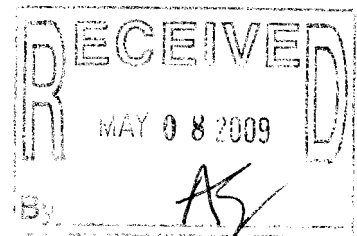



PART I

Statement of Work

This agreement is entered into by the South Carolina Department of Commerce (SCDOC) and Greenville County (hereinafter referred to as the Grantee) on behalf of the Greenville Local Workforce Investment Area (LWIA), pursuant to the provisions and regulations of the Workforce Investment Act (WIA).

1.0 Purpose

1.0.1 This grant provides WIA state reserve funds through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) to ensure the availability of and access to adult basic education services for WIA participants during the summer months of 2009.

1.1 Project Description

1.1.1 In these challenging times of budget cuts and increased demand for services, grant funds will be used to ensure the provision of adult basic education services throughout the region. The Grantee will enter into subgrants with local education and literacy entities.

1.1.2 The Grantee will ensure that funds are used for activities that are in addition to those that would otherwise be available in the local area in the absence of such funds.

1.1.3 The Grantee will prioritize the use of funds based on the level of award and the geographic need in the region.

1.2 Reporting

1.2.1 The Grantee will comply with financial reporting requirements applicable to ARRA funds. Such requirements may involve expedited and/or increased frequency of reporting.

1.2.2 The Grantee will ensure that all recipients of the services provided by this grant are WIA participants and enrolled in the Virtual OneStop (VOS) system.

1.2.3 Sub-tier agreements between the Grantee and local education and/or literacy entities will be submitted to the SCDOC grant manager in the Workforce Division upon execution of such agreements.
